LAKE VICTORIA ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROJECT PHASE II

The East African Community (EAC) has received financing from the International Development Association (IDA) acting as the implementing Agency of the Global Environmental Facility (GEF) and the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) towards the cost of activities under the second phase of the Lake Victoria Environmental Management Project (LVEMP II), and intends to apply part of the proceeds of these Grants for consultancy services. The services include review and harmonization of regional policies, legal and institutional frameworks governing utilization of water and other natural resources in the Lake Victoria Basin.

The LVEMP-II is a regional initiative implemented by the five EAC Partner States of Burundi, Kenya, Rwanda, Tanzania and Uganda. The Project contributes to the vision of EAC/LVBC for the Lake Victoria Basin of “*a prosperous population living in a healthy and sustainably managed environment and providing equitable opportunities and benefits*”. The Project is regionally coordinated by the Lake Victoria Basin Commission (LVBC).

LVBC now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the following consultancy services.

1. Consultancy services to expand an Atmospheric Deposition Monitoring Network in the Lake Victoria Basin – **LVBC/LVEMPII/2009-10/CS/08**
2. Consultancy services to develop Information and Data Sharing Protocol among and within countries and agencies including production and dissemination of data, information and knowledge – **LVBC/LVEMPII/2009-10/CS/14**
