CONSULTING SERVICES FOR MONITORING OF THE WATER QUALITY AT THE INTAKES OF MWANZA, MUSOMA AND BUKOBA IN THE LAKE VICTORIA

- 1. The Ministry of Water has received a financing from Agence Française de Développement ("**AFD**"), and intends to use part of the funds thereof for payments under the following project monitoring of the Water Quality at the Intakes of Mwanza, Musoma and Bukoba in the Lake Victoria.
- 2. The Services of the consultant shall consist of supporting the monitoring of the water quality at the water intakes. The main objective of this assignment is to implement a monitoring system of the water quality at intake locations in order to improve the quality of raw water and create awareness and understanding the risks posed to water supplies by pollution of the Lake Victoria, to finally adapt the treatment system. The monitoring plan will focus on water quality in three sites used for the production of drinking water: Mwanza, Bukoba and Musoma. The Consultant will define and support the implementation of the global monitoring strategy and basically define: the role of the technical committee, the location of the sampling points, the frequency of the monitoring, the physico-chemical and biological monitored parameters, the sampling procedures, methodologies used for the analyses, equipment and skills required, and the way of dissemination of results. The consultant will also ensure training program for people involved in the water quality monitoring. The consultant shall also contribute to the elaboration and implementation of Water Safety Plans in the three utilities.
- 3. The assignment will be undertaken in a period of Twenty Four (24) months and would mobilize around 40 experts-months.

- 4. The Ministry of Water hereby invites Applicants to show their interest in delivering the Services described above. The Request for Expressions of Interest is open to Consulting Firms only.
- 5. Eligibility criteria to AFD financing are specified in sub-clause 1.3 of the "Procurement Guidelines for AFD-Financed Contracts in Foreign Countries", available online on AFD's website: http://www.afd.fr.
- 6. The Applicant shall submit only one application, either in its own name or as a member of a Joint Venture (JV). If an Applicant (including any JV member) submits or participates in more than one application, those applications shall be all rejected. However, the same Sub consultant may participate in several applications.

If the Applicant is a JV, the expression of interest shall include a copy of the JV Agreement entered into by all members or a letter of intent to execute a JV Agreement, signed by all members together with a copy of the Agreement proposal. In the absence of this document, the other members will be considered as Sub consultants.

- 7. Experiences and qualifications of Sub consultants are not taken into account in the evaluation of the applications.
- 8. Interested Applicants must provide information evidencing that they are qualified and experienced to perform those Services. For that purpose, documented evidence of recent and similar services shall be submitted.

Determination of the similarity of the experiences will be based on:

- The contracts size;
- The nature of the Services: definition of monitoring systems of the water quality, implementation of monitoring systems of the water quality, implementation of training programs,
- The location: experience of having worked in sub-Saharan Africa or similar environment, having worked in the region Lake Victoria Basins would be an advantage

The Client will also take into account for the evaluation of the applications the following items:

- The Consultant must possess a proven experience in water quality management (monitoring & assessment), from the definition until its implementation, including the data bank production and training sessions
- The consultant must rely on local scientific expertise and
- Expertise in development and implementation of Water Safety Plans will be an added advantage
- 9. Among the submitted applications, the Ministry of Water will shortlist a maximum of six (6) Applicants, to whom the Request for Proposals to carry out the Services shall be sent.
- 10. The Expression of Interest marked "CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR MONITORING OF THE WATER QUALITY AT THE INTAKES OF MWANZA, MUSOMA AND BUKOBA IN THE LAKE VICTORIA" should be delivered in a written form to the address below (in person, or by courier, or by e-mail) by 7th February, 2020 before 14:00 hour's local time
