Bidding will be conducted through national competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers of July 2016 revised November 2017 ("Procurement Regulations"), as well as Public Procurement (Goods, Works, Non Consultant Service and Disposal of Public Assets by Tender) Regulations, 2013 Government Notice No.446 and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
